PANJAB UNIVERSITY, CHANDIGARH

Minutes of the meeting of the Committee, appointed by the Vice-Chancellor, in terms of the Syndicate decision (Para 37) dated 9.12.1991 to consider as a matter of policy, the issue of grant of the medals on the basis of original results/re-evaluation results to implement the decision by all the Universities in the region as a common policy, held on 14.12.1992 at 2.45 p.m. in the office of the Controller of Examinations, Panjab University, Chandigarh.

The Controller of Examinations, Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, could not attend the meeting.

It was noted that the Syndicate of Panjab University at its meeting held on 9.12.1991, vide Para 37 had taken the following decision:

"Considered recommendation of the Committee dated 22.10.1991, appointed by the Vice-Chancellor, for examining the office note together with the advice of the University Counsel for the implementation of the judgement of the Division Bench of Punjab & Haryana High Court in the Civil writ petition No. 5663 of 1991, Miss Samrita Kaur Gill Versus Panjab University, Chandigarh.

RESOLVED : That the medals be awarded in the ensuing convocation to the candidates on the basis of re-evaluation results.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That as a matter of policy, the issue of grant of medals on the basis of original results/re-evaluation results may be decided by all the Universities in the region after due consideration so that a common policy was adopted".

It was also noted that Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, had made the following amendment in the relevant Ordinance for giving the benefit of re-evaluation award for preparing the Merit Lists:

"Provided that the names of only those candidates shall be included in the merit list, who passed the examination as a whole in the first attempt.

Provided further that the result after re-evaluation, if any, be considered as first attempt and the merit Lists prepared at the time of declaration of original results will be modified in accordance with this result".

At Punjabi University, Patiala, the Merit Lists are prepared and finalised on the basis of original annual examination results, as stated in the meeting by the Deputy Registrar (Examinations), Punjabi University, Patiala.

After detailed discussion, it was recommended as under:-

- I. That the Merit Lists be prepared provisionally on the basis of original annual examination results.
- II. The Merit Lists be revised on the basis of re-evaluation results taking into account the re-evaluation results of all those parts/semesters for the examinations where the result of the final examination was declared on the basis of total marks obtained by the candidate in different parts/semesters.
- III. That in order to give fair chance to those who had not applied for re-evaluation, a sampling of answer-sheets of candidates, who had obtained higher as well as lower marks, than the candidates who had applied for re-evaluation be prepared and given to the examiners before re-evaluating the answer-sheets of the candidates who had applied for re-evaluation.
- IV. That in future the marks of Result Later cases where the awards had been received in examination Branches be intimated to the candidates for purpose of re-evaluation only. In these cases the rules provided for the purpose will stand i.e. the candidate can submit his/her form for re-evaluation within 21 days from the date of despatch of letter of intimation of marks.
